Anthony D. Whittemore, M.D., a native of Boston, is Chief Medical Officer of Brigham and Women’s Hospital, having served as Chairman of both Medical Staff Executive and Quality Assurance Risk Management Committees, as well as Director of the multidisciplinary BWH Vascular Center.

Dr. Whittemore is a member of 20 professional societies, including the American Medical Association, American College of Surgeons, American Surgical Association, Society of University Surgeons, and has served as President of the Boston Surgical Society, New England Society for Vascular Surgery, and the Society for Vascular Surgery.

He has served as Treasurer of the American Surgical Association and its Foundation, and is currently Secretary-General of the International Federation of Vascular Societies.

Dr. Whittemore’s publications exceed 100 peer-reviewed scientific papers and an equal number of textbook chapters and educationally relevant material. He served on the editorial boards of numerous publications, including *The Journal of Vascular Surgery*, *The Journal of the American College of Surgeons*, *Vascular Surgery*, and *Cardiovascular Surgery*. He served as Editor-in-Chief of *Advances in Vascular Surgery* from its inception in 1991 until 2001.
