2009 STUDENT INITIATIVE PROGRAM

As part of its ongoing effort to encourage students to explore vascular surgery as a specialty, the New England Society for Vascular Surgery established a sponsorship program to enable medical school students and residents to attend the Annual Meeting of the Society. Sponsorships are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis, divided evenly between medical students and general surgery residents, as well as fairly distributed among the various institutions within the region. Medical students and residents (PGY 1-3) attending an accredited program in one of the six New England states are eligible for sponsorship. Fellows are not eligible.

ELIGIBILITY & NOTIFICATION

Medical students and residents (PGY 1-3) attending an accredited program in one of the six New England states are eligible for sponsorship. Fellows are not eligible. Applications must be received no later than **Friday, August 21, 2009**. Notification will be sent to accepted individuals via email prior to the Annual Meeting.

SPONSORSHIP INCLUDES

Complimentary Annual Meeting registration (Postgraduate Course is by separate subscription) and expense reimbursement. **This year's Annual Meeting will be held at the Seaport Hotel in Boston, Massachusetts from October 2-4, 2009.**

- Up to \$150.00 in travel expenses for those living within 25-miles of downtown Boston (mileage, parking/tolls, meals).
- Up to \$500.00 in travel expenses for those living more than 25-miles from downtown Boston (mileage, parking/tolls, meals, hotel accommodations at the headquarters hotel).

The Student Initiative Program offers students and residents a unique opportunity to sit with the NESVS leadership to discuss vascular surgery, memorable events from the training years of senior surgeons and cases of their choosing in a small group setting.
